#### SBH BUSINESS COHORTS UPDATE

Between April and June, we conducted meetings with Savaii Business Cohorts which took place from April 8<sup>th</sup> to the 11<sup>th</sup>, involving five different business cohorts. In Upolu, the 9 established business cohorts met with our CEED Division from May 14<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup>, each at their designated times. Additionally, a newly formed business cohort for Lalomanu, Satitoa, Saleaaumua and Tiavea held their first meeting during this period.



These scheduled gatherings every month are vital platforms that foster learning, collaboration and shared growth among MSMEs out in the community. They play a crucial role in strengthening local economies and community development by providing entrepreneurs with support, resources and netowrking opportunities. This ongoing engagement helps empower community-based enterprises to thrive, innovate and contribute meaningfully to the social and economic fabric of Samoa.

# STRENGTHENING FINANCIAL SKILLS FOR FARMERS IN UPOLU-WITH PHAMA PLUS

# SBH successfully concluded a 3-day *Financial Literacy and Management Training* from *April 28-30* for beneficiaries under the **PHAMA Plus Program-Upolu Cohort.**

The training was designed to enhance the financial capabilities of local farmers, equipping them with practical tools to better manage their agribusiness operations, improve decision-making, and ensure long-term sustainability. Since 2011, PHAMA Plus has been working with Pacific businesses, industry groups and government partners to strengthen trade in agricultural and horticultural products. The program emphasizes gender equality, climate resilience and inclusive growth, helping market actors adopt innovation, improve practices and meet export requirements. SBH is extremely proud to continue supporting these efforts by building foundational business skills that empower our farmers to thrive in both local and global markets.





#### FINANCIAL LITERACY & MANAGEMENT TRAINING: PHAMA PLUS BENEFICIARIES IN SAVAII





From May 6-8, SBH's Special Projects Division delivered a 3-day Financial Literacy and Management Training in Savaii for beneficiaries under PHAMA Plus Program- Savaii Cohort.

The training kicked off with interactive and practical sessions aimed at equipping local farmers with essential financial skills to better manage and grow their agribusinesses. Delivered under SBH's partnership with the Pacific Horticultural and Agricultural Market Access Plus (PHAMA Plus) Program, the initiative focused on strengthening the capacity of farmers through tailored support in financial literacy and business management.

# SMALL BUSINESS OPERATIONS(SBOII) UPDATE SEMESTER 1, 2025

Semester 1 of our SMALL BUSINESS OPERATIONS CERTIFICATE LEVEL 2 officially concluded at the end of June, with 18 trainees successfully completing the course and now eligible for graduation. We commend all of our trainees for their dedication and look forward to celebrating their achievements.

As part of our ongoing efforts to strengthen practical learning, we were privileged to hold a series of insightful presentations and guest sessions delivered by key government and community stakeholders. Our sincere appreciation goes out to the Ministry of Commerce Industry (MCIL), Samoa Police & Corrections Services (SPCS), Samoa Red Cross and Ministry of Customs and Revenue (MCR). Their involvement greatly enriched the learning experience by offering real-world insights and professional guidance to our trainees.

Meanwhile, registration for Semester 2 opened in early June, and we are excited to welcome anew intake of aspiring business operators. This continued momentum reflects our shared commitment to building capable entrepreneurs who are well-equipped to contribute meaningfully to Samoa' economic development.







#### **BLP UPDATE**

As part of our ongoing collaboration with Business Link Pacific(BLP) through the Samoa Chamber of Commerce, SBH has been actively supporting local SMEs under the BLP SME grant Initiative. This quarter, our MSME Development Division conducted field visits to the grant beneficiaries allocated to SBH in Savaii. These visits were a crucial step in understanding each business's current operations and needs, and in beginning the development of tailored business plans.






#### **BUSINESS ADVISORY**

Throughout this quarter, our Community Empowerment & Entrepreneurship Development Division and MSME Development Divisions continued to provide targeted business advisory support to clients across Upolu and Savai'i. This included weekly and fortnightly follow-visits to clients in critical arrears, offering hands-on guidance to help them address challenges and strengthen their business operations. In addition, one and one advisory sessions were also delivered through office walk-ins and phone consultations.

Complementing these efforts, our Legal and Recovery Division also conducted weekly visits to clients undergoing foreclosure processes. While the primary focus is on repayment collections, these visits also served as an opportunity to provide business advisory services, helping clients explore options for recovery and long-term sustainability.
